He has operated on both Hotshot fire crews and as a rapid response helicopter deployed firefighter.

Currently Fred spends his winters working with an Antarctic based logistics company as an aviation coordinator and safety advisor. Down on “the ice” he helps train a staff of 70 in risk assessment and emergency response. From time to time he also fills in as a lead guide and avalanche educator at a premier helicopter skiing operation based in Nevada’s Ruby Mountains.
